### Uniface JTi is being rebranded

- Clearer reflection of capabilities
- Uniface Anywhere 4.8.2
  - We're currently verifying
  - All visual aspects are rebranded
  - Compuware references removed
    - (except the registry!)
  - Resolves some reported issues
  - Supports MS Office 2013



### Turning up the heat on quality



- Structured project approach to development and maintenance
  - Review the current functionality
  - Review the expected functionality
  - Review the documentation
  - Make a list and work through it
- Projects this year:
  - Discard statement



- Grid widget
- Unicode date handling

### Turning up the heat on quality

- GUI testing tool replacement
- Ranorex is the replacement tooling
- Implementation underway in Uniface
- Windows client/server



### Uniface Security Certification

- Uniface is checked by Veracode
  - Static deployment components
  - Dynamic components are application design
- Next steps:
  - VerAfied certification
  - Integration into our automated build and test processes






#### Uniface 9.7

- Aiming for a Q3 2015 delivery
- Addition to the roadmap, <u>nothing</u> changes for Uniface 9.6
  - Support life cycle <u>remains as previously communicated</u>
  - Migration from Uniface 9.6 to Uniface 10.02 as <u>previously</u> <u>communicated</u>.
  - Uniface 9.7 is <u>NOT</u> mandatory to migrate to Uniface 10.
- Move from 9.6 9.7 will require recompilation
- This is usual! Nothing new!
- Enables us to deliver mobile (and web) enhancements in Uniface 9

### Uniface 9.7 planned content

- Web services enhancements
  - CURL error handling
  - Binary objects
  - Struct performance tweaks
- Currency Uniface 9.7 will not be available on Windows XP
  - We plan to move to MS Visual Studio 2013
  - Opens up other possibilities
    - Refactoring
    - Windows features and functionality


